HAPPINNESS VS. JOY

CONTRARY TO POPULAR BELIEF HAPINESS AND JOY ARE NOT THE SAME THING.

Ways they are similar:

- bring a smile to your face,
- cause laughter
- makes your heart feel lighter

What other similarities are there?

Ways they are different:

- happiness is based on circumstance, joy is based on God
- happiness comes from within, joy comes from God
- happiness comes from success after trusting ourselves, joy comes from trusting God

What other differences are there?

WHY IS JOY ELUSIVE?

- We think of it as happiness.
- We let our circumstances dictate our emotional state.
- We fail to see God in the midst of what we are facing.
- We fail to trust God when circumstances are difficult or seemingly impossible.
- We do not see God as in control so we try to control things ourselves.
- We think we have control over joy, and try to create it for ourselves.
- Our circumstances overwhelm us and instead of reaching out to God we just try to survive it.
- We don't trust God to handle it because we think He has failed us in the past.
- Allow our focus to wander from God to other things.
- We don't believe we are worthy of it.

What are some other reasons why joy may evade us at times?

Oh, the joys of those who do not follow the advice of the wicked, or stand around with sinners, or join in with mockers. But they delight in the law of the Lord, meditating on it day and night. They are like trees planted along the riverbank, bearing fruit each season. Their leaves never wither, and they prosper in all they do. *Psalm 1:1-3*

Activation

Keep this list and as you go through this month continue to tackle obstacles until you find the joy that has been missing.
